Introduction:

- Matthew 28:18-20
- Omission "Something left out ... Not done ... Neglected."

1. All Authority:

- a. <u>Exousia</u> (Greek) English <u>Authority</u> … "Absolute authority to rule and have control."
- b. Matthew 28:18
- c. But what does that mean? We only know authority from a Finite point of view Meaning: very limited.
- d. The authority of God is not limited in any way at all ... Do you understand that?
- e. God has the authority to do the following:
 - i. Speak the Heavens and Earth into existence Ex Nihilo Out of nothing. Genesis 1-2
 - ii. Change the language of the people Genesis 11
 - iii. Cause a barren woman of 90 to have a child Genesis 21
 - iv. Give a boy named Joseph the second highest position in Egypt even though he was Jewish **Genesis 39**
 - v. To save the nation of Israel during a famine Genesis 47
 - vi. To part the Red Sea Exodus 13
 - vii. To hold the sun and moon in place for a day and a half Joshua 10
 - viii. To Step out of eternity and into our world Luke 2
 - ix. To heal all kinds of ailments Matthew 8; 9; 14
 - x. To take the full wrath of sin and rise from the dead Matthew 27-28
 - xi. One day, He will return to get His Church 1st Thessalonians 4
- f. Matthew 28:18
- g. Jesus isn't the founder of Christianity He is God!
- h. Philippians 2:9-11
- i. Revelation 20:11-15
- j. What makes something matter to us, is the authority behind it.

2. Therefore, Go!

- a. Matthew 28:19-20
- b. Therefore "In consequent of ... Because of ... as a result of."
- c. Mission "A task, an assignment that must be accomplished."
- d. <u>Commission</u> "The act of committing or entrusting a person with power and authority to accomplish a task or mission."
- e. Four questions with Four answers:

- i. What is the mission? Go make disciples of all nations.
 - 1. **Ethnos** Different people groups.
- ii. <u>How do we do that?</u> Baptizing them in the name of the Father, and the Son, and the Holy Spirit.
 - 1. **Baptizo** To be plunged under, to be covered, to bury. (Acts 2:38)
- iii. After baptism, then what? Teach them everything I have commanded you.
- iv. How can I possibly do this? I am with you always. (Philippians 4:13 ... 2nd Timothy 2:15)
- f. Omission "Something left out ... not done ... neglected."

3. I AM with you always.

- a. Matthew 28:20
- b. If you are a baptized believer Jesus is with you always!
- c. Do you realize that in this Promise He reminds us of two names that show His love and Power?
 - i. Matthew 1:23 Immanuel
 - ii. Exodus 3:13-14 The Great I AM
- **d.** Matthew 28:20
- e. Greek <u>Aion</u> ... English <u>Era</u> ... means, "A period of history or time having some distinct feature."
- f. When it comes to living your life, live in a way that is pleasing and honoring to God without Omission!
- g. Do not leave out the AUTHORITY of Jesus Christ.
- h. We are called to:
 - i. Faith Romans 10:17
 - ii. Believe John 3:16
 - iii. Repent Luke 13:3
 - iv. Confess Philippians 2:1-11 ... Matthew 10:32
 - v. Baptism Acts 2:38 ... Mark 16:16
 - vi. Faithfulness James 1:12 ... Revelation 2:10
- i. Does anyone have the authority to omit any of those? Absolutely not.
- j. The Great Commission is a forward moving plan to free millions from the bondage of sin.
