Introduction:

- Greek – **Apologia** ... English – Apologetics ... “A Formal defense of an opinion, position or action.”
 - **1st Peter 3:15**
 - **2nd Timothy 3:16-17**
 - Worldview – The way by which I see and interpret all things around me.
 - Belief – Confidence in the truth or existence of something.
 - Conviction – A fixed or firm belief.
 - **Proverbs 22:6**
 - **2nd Corinthians 10:3-5**
 - The answer is simple ... their beliefs, were not CONVICTIONS!
 - REAL CONVICTION ... makes all the difference when you live in a world where conviction is subjective to interpretation.

 - 2. Hell – **2nd Thessalonians 1:9 ... Matthew 13:50 ... Mark 9:43 ... Matthew 25:41 ... Luke 16:28 ... Matthew 25:21**
 - v. What is the purpose of history?
