1. Moses Runs Ahead of God:

- a. **Exodus 2:11-14**
- b. What do I mean by, “Running ahead of God?” ... It is assuming that you know what God wants in your life, and you know how He wants you to get there without ever once asking for God’s guidance.

2. God Gives Moses His Identity:

- a. **Exodus 3:1-6**
- b. Gershom ... Which means, “An Alien here.”
- c. **Exodus 3:4-6**
- d. I am the God of your father, the God of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob. In other words, Moses, I am YOUR God and you belong to Me.
- e. **Ephesians 2:1-3** - We were – Dead in our sins ... Following Satan and the culture of the world ... accepting as okay all that the world said was okay ... We were filling ourselves with the sinful desires of the world ... AND ... we deserved the wrath of God.
- f. **Ephesians 2:4-10** - You are - So loved by God that He gave His life for you to pay for your sins ... He has saved you because He is gracious and has mercy ... You are His creation in His Image ... He Created you to do the good works that only you can do.
- g. **Matthew 28:18-20**

3. Moses Chose Faith over Fear:

- a. **Deuteronomy 34:10-12**
- b. Your identity is attached to who God is ... If you do not know God ... You cannot know yourself ... AND ... if you do not know God or who you are ... You are bound to wander aimlessly in wilderness of life, never finding or really knowing where you belong.
- c. The Presence of God changes things.
- d. **Matthew 28:18-20**
- e. We know what Moses did ... **BUT ... what about you?** ... What will you choose, FAITH ... OR ... FEAR?
