- Is there a problem with scripture here? NO.
- So, why the difference in names? ... Well ... out of all these, there is only one name <u>Jesus</u>. The rest are Messianic Titles.
- Hebrew <u>Yeshua</u> ... English <u>Jesus</u> ... means ... "The Lord Saves."
- 1. The Humble Birth:
 - a. Luke 2:4-7
 - b. Caesar thought he was enacting his will on the Roman world ... Really, what was happening, God was allowing him to play a small role in the Messianic Prophesy.
 - c. Bethlehem was the town from which Joseph's family lineage was from.
 - d. Bethlehem was a small sleep little town: Population:
 - i. In 2015 26,000
 - ii. In 1596 AD Ottoman Empire had it at 1,435
 - iii. 1st Century Around 300-600 people.
 - e. Micah 5:2
 - f. Why did the world of the 1st Century refuse to accept Jesus? ... Because He wasn't one of their own. He didn't fit what they thought the Messiah should be.
 - g. Consider the facts of Jesus's birth:
 - i. Not born in comfort at all.
 - ii. Stable A resting place for animals
 - iii. Strips of cloth were His first outfit.
 - iv. Placed in a feeding trough.
 - v. The world neglected Him from the beginning.
 - vi. Born in poverty
 - vii. Born in loneliness
 - viii. Born in a Corrupt world
 - h. So many people missed His first coming ... How many will miss His Second Coming?

- m. How is your humility today? ... Do you have any room for Jesus?

- a. Luke 2:8-14
- b. We know several things that society did not accept:
 - i. John 1:43-46
 - ii. Joseph and Mary from Nazareth
 - iii. They are poor This came with faulty theology.
 - iv. Born in the little town of Bethlehem
 - v. Now The Birth of the Messiah is announced to shepherds!
- c. When Samuel was looking for the next king of Israel:
 - i. 1st Samuel 16:11
 - ii. Hebrew <u>Haqatan</u> ... English <u>Youngest</u> ... means, "Insignificant, unimportant."
- d. Shekinah Glory Glory of God Radiance of Brilliant Light.
- e. Luke 2:10
- f. Two words of importance Christ and Lord:
- g. Greek <u>Christos</u> ... English <u>Christ</u> ... "The Messiah, the Christ."
- h. Greek <u>Kyrios</u> ... English <u>Lord</u> ... "The One who exercises supernatural authority over all mankind and creation ... Lord, Ruler God."
- i. As long as you carry your sin, you are at war with God.

- k. That is why Jesus stepped into our world.

- a. Luke 2:15-20
- b. After the announcement, the shepherds hurried off to see what they were told about.
- c. Notice what they did after they saw Jesus ... They told everyone else what happened.
- d. Greek <u>Thaumazo</u> ... English <u>Amazed</u> ... means ... "To marvel ... to be astonished ... to wonder."
- e. Joseph and Mary had only a few visitors that night, the shepherds who came.
- f. I bet the shepherds were amazed that such an important announcement was given to them, since the world considered them "Haqatans."
- g. Maybe you feel like a "Haqatan" from Nowhere, USA at times ... that you don't really matter.
- h. God doesn't see you as a Haqatan ... He never has and He never will ... He loves you more than you know.
- i. We are the reason He stepped into our world John 3:16
- j. Mary Treasured up all these things in her heart What does that mean?
- k. Greek <u>Syntereo</u> (Syn-Tear-O) ... English Treasured ... means, ... "To store in your mind ... to ponder ... to think about."
- 1. The Birth of Jesus in Bethlehem is important for you to know, understand and comprehend.
- m. BUT ... The Birth of Jesus in your life is the ONLY thing that can change your eternity.
- n. This is GOOD NEWS for everyone ... BUT ... Is it good news for you?
