- a. John 1:43-46
- **b.** Who are Mary and Joseph? We don't know a lot about them. But I don't think that is a bad thing either ... I think we forget that sometimes.
- c. We cannot forget that the Bible highlights one person above all else and that is Jesus Christ ... and that is the way it should be.
- d. <u>Joseph</u> ... The name means, "May He add" ... first record of the name is in **Genesis** 30:22-24
 - i. He is a God-fearing man who loved his wife very much.
 - ii. Legally, he could have had Mary stoned to death for infidelity.
 - iii. Matthew 1:19
 - iv. Matthew 1:20-22
 - v. Matthew 1:24-25
 - vi. Hebrew Yeshua ... English Jesus ... means ... "The Lord Saves."
- e. Mary ... comes from Miriam and it means, "Sea of Bitterness."

 - 1. She was highly favored Greek- Charitoo ... English Favored ... means, "Favor bestowed upon."

 - 3. She was blessed among women Luke 1:42
 - iii. What did "Betrothed" mean? ... Was it the same as being engaged today? NO.
 - iv. Betrothal was a legally binding commitment with two parts:
 - 1. <u>Formal agreement</u> The bridal price was paid and it was a witnessed event. The couple is actually married at this point.
 - 2. <u>The groom would prepare the house</u> After doing so he would return to get his wife and take her to their home.
