- The "Big Jake Principle" Matt Proctor
- Let's be honest ... The Christian life isn't easy or simple.
- John 14:33
- Acts 14:22
- 1st Peter 4:12
- Have you ever been tempted to just stop? (Your Christian Walk)
- Do you remember what it felt like when you first became a Christian?
- 2nd Timothy 1:2
- Greek <u>Agapeto</u> ... English <u>Dear</u> ... "Very dear to someone ... Beloved."
- 2nd Timothy 1:4
- Philippians 2:20
- Two questions:
 - o Do you have someone like Timothy in your life?
 - O Do you have someone like Paul?
- Later, Paul hears bad news about the church in Ephesus:
 - Divisive (1 Tim. 2:8)
 - o Materialism has crept into the church thinking. (1 Tim. 6:5-10)
 - o False Teachings ... Perverting the Gospel (1 Tim.1:19-20 ... 1 Tim. 4:1-3)

1. Difficult Assignment:

- a. Giving correction is always harder than giving direction.
- b. Timothy feels like he has three strikes against him:
 - i. He is young -1^{st} Timothy 4:12
 - ii. He was sickly 1st Timothy 5:23
 - iii. He was a bit of an introvert 1st Timothy 4:14 ... 1st Timothy 6:12 ... 2nd Timothy 1:6-7
- c. "If the Christian Life is a race, have you ever felt like quitting?"

2. A Determined Believer:

- a. 2nd Timothy 4:6
- b. 2nd Timothy 1:15
- c. Mark 4 Parable of the Sower
- d. Every person that walks away from the Lord, will take with them a failed mission for God.

3. A Divine Encouragement:

- a. Paul gives Timothy a charge: "Don't quit! ... Be Faithful!"
- b. 2nd Timothy 1:2
- c. What is Grace ... It is God giving His attention to the undeserving.
- d. What is Mercy ... It is God giving His aid to the unable.
- e. What is Peace ... It is God giving His spiritual health to the unwell.
- f. Timothy finished strong in his ministry.
- g. REMEMBER, the Big Jake principle: "It is not how you start the race that matters. It is how you finish!"
