  - Joshua’s name in Hebrew is pronounced; Yeshua. This name in English is pronounced, Jesus.
  - It means, “Yahweh (the Lord) is my Salvation.”

  - He faced a God size task
  - It was to be done in God’s timing.
  - He was Leading the People of God.
- God Size Task – Deuteronomy 34:10-12
- Timing is everything, and this was to be done in God’s Time – Joshua 3:15-16
- Joshua was in charge of God’s people.
