- a. Greek Exousia ... English Authority ... "Absolute authority to rule and have control."
- b. Matthew 28:18
- c. The Authority of God is not limited in any way, shape or form.
- d. What does Absolute Authority mean?
  - To speak the Heavens and the Earth and all that are in and on them into existence
    ... Ex Nihilo meaning ... "Out of nothing" Genesis 1-2
  - ii. To change the language of mankind from one to many different languages because people were conspiring against God **Genesis 11**
  - iii. To cause a barren woman at the age of 90 to have a child which would lead to the nation of Israel **Genesis 21**
