### **Introduction:**

- Matthew 28:18-20
- Greek <u>Matheteuo</u> (Math-A-Two-O) ... English <u>Disciple</u> ... means, ... "To be or become a pupil ... follow the teachings of ... to learn."
- <u>Dictionary.com</u> says ... <u>Disciple</u> A person who is a pupil or adherent of the doctrines and teachings of another person.
