## 1. Contend For the Faith:

- a. Jude 1:3
- b. Greek <u>Epagonizomai</u> ... English <u>Contend</u> ... "To exert intense effort on behalf of something ... To struggle for ... To Fight for."
- c. There is **NO NEW Truth** when it comes to the Gospel ... We Cannot ... and We MUST not allow the enemies of God to change it ... whether those enemies are <u>outside the church</u> ... **OR** ... <u>inside the church</u> ... We must contend for the Faith no matter what.
- d. Jude gives two specific areas that then, fan out into many other areas of life:
  - i. Godless men who have changed the Grace of God into a license for immorality.
  - ii. They deny Jesus Christ as Lord.

  - i. The Lord has returned and we didn't see it.
  - ii. No need to be baptized.
  - iii. You can be baptized for a deceased relative so they can be saved.
  - iv. Live anyway you want ... Any lifestyle you want. Just be nice to others and you will be fine.
  - v. No need to go to church. All nice people go to Heaven, if there is one.
  - vi. There is no Heaven or Hell ... Love is all that matters.
