Introduction

- General lessons we learn from the Bible:
 - We cannot cover our shame God must do that Genesis 3:21
 - We cannot set ourselves free Only God can break the chains of bondage –
 Exodus 7-14
- Jesus' first Triumphal Entry Luke 2:13-14

1. What is the Situation?

- a. **Exodus 12** The Passover
- b. Matthew 21:1-9
- c. The blood of animals could not atone for sin, it merely pushed them back for a year.

The Passover was a reminder:

- i. Sin brought death into the world.
- ii. Sin caused the shedding of innocent blood.
- d. Sin brought absolute bondage and death.
 - i. The only way to be free is by the Hand of God.
 - ii. The only way to be spared is to be marked by the Blood of the Unblemished Lamb.
- e. Genesis 3:15
- f. Since the Garden, we have been waiting for the Messiah to set us free.
- g. What is our situation in 2023?
 - i. Sanity ... Individual Thinking ... and Truth are public enemy number one.
- h. Three major reasons why:
 - i. No desire to know the True God or His Ways
 - ii. Narcissistic Thinking
 - iii. Pride
- i. Two kinds of people:
 - i. The Saved
 - ii. The Lost
- j. The Lost have three categories:
 - i. Those who think they are saved.
 - ii. Those who are genuine in their desire to be changed by God.
 - iii. Those who could care less about God and His Ways.
- k. The situation of the world is a mess!

- b. If we live in opposition against the Morals, Precepts, and Principles of God, there is a punishment.
- c. In a world of "Safe Spaces" that seems so mean and terrible.

- b. Jesus' Mission:

 - ii. The full wrath of God for every man, woman, and child past, present and future, would be placed on Him.
 - iii. He will take our place He will pay our penalty for sin.
 - iv. Can you imagine that burden?

 - i. What joy could be found in a Roman crucifixion?
 - ii. The joy of knowing, we could now come back home.
- d. Our Mission:
 - i. All we have to do is respond to His invitation to be saved.
 - ii. We respond to His Terms of Pardon.
 - iii. What could possibly keep us from this free gift?
