- Greek – **Parakeleo** ... English – **Urge** ... means ... *“To ask with earnest propriety ... to plead ... to appeal ... to implore ... to beg.”*
- Greek – **Oiktirmos** (*Oyk-Tear-Mos*) ... English – **Mercy** ... means ... *“To show compassion, tenderness and sympathy.”*
- Greek – **Thysia** (*Thu-see-Ya*) ... English – **Sacrifice** ... means ... *“That which has value being offered up in replacement of something or someone else.”*
- Like **John 3:16** ... In the letter to the Romans, we do not find the Terms for Pardon ... These people are already saved in Christ as they were called to do in **Matthew 28:18-20** and **Acts 2:38**.

- e. Greek – **Parakaleo** ... English – **Encourage** ... Means, *“To give hope ... to lift up ... to encourage.”*
- f. Greek – **Metadidomi** (*Meta-Did-O-My*) ... English – **Contribute** ... Means, *“To share with someone what you have.”*
- g. Greek – **Proistemi** (*Pro-East-I-Me*) ... English – **Leader** ... Means ... *“To influence others ... to cause them to follow a recommended course.”*
