 - i. David is dead and we know where he is buried: **Psalm 16**
 - ii. Jesus is a descendant of David from both sides: 2nd Sanuel 7:16
 - iii. David spoke about the Messiah not being left in the grave:
 - iv. God raised Jesus to life and He is exalted at the Right Hand of God:
 - **Acts 2:32 ... Deuteronomy 19:15**

- i. Greek <u>Parresia</u> (Par-Ray-See-A) ... English <u>Confidently</u> ... "Confidence ... Boldness ... Plainly."
- j. Acts 2:36
- k. Greek <u>Kyrios</u> ... English <u>Lord</u> ... "Lord, Ruler ... One who commands."
- 1. Greek Christos ... English Christ ... "The Christ ... The Messiah."

- b. Greek <u>Katanyssomai</u> (*Kata-New-So-My*) ... English <u>Cut to the Heart</u> ... "*They were pierced* ... *Stabbed*."
- c. When I am in my sins, my status is an enemy of God.
- d. Matthew 12:30
- e. John 3:17
- f. John 14:6
- g. Matthew 28:18-20
- h. The Terms of Pardon:
 - i. Repent
 - ii. Be Baptized
 - 1. I receive:
 - a. Forgiveness of sins
 - b. Gift of the Holy Spirit (Indwelling)
- i. Greek <u>Metanoeo</u> ... English <u>Repent</u> ... "To change one's way of life as the result of a complete change of thought and attitude with regard to sin and righteousness."
- j. Greek <u>Baptizo</u> ... English <u>Baptize</u> ... means ... "To be plunged under water, to completely cover ... to be immersed ... to bury."
- k. Terms of Pardon As laid out in the whole New Testament:
 - i. Faith **Romans 10:17**
 - ii. Believe John 3:16
 - iii. Repentance Luke 13:3
 - iv. Confess **Matthew 10:32-33**
 - v. Baptize Mark 16:16 ... Acts 2:38
 - vi. Faithfulness James 1:12
