- a. John's birth announcement was given to Zachariah, John's father.
- b. This week Jesus' announcement was given to his mother, a young peasant girl from Nazareth.
- c. Listen to what the people thought of Nazareth **John 1:43-46**
- d. Who are Mary and Joseph? We must look at Matthew to find who Joseph is.
- e. Jospeh means, "May he add."
  - i. **Genesis 30:24** First record of the name, Joseph.
  - ii. **Matthew 1:19** Allows us to look at his heart and see his deep love for Mary.
  - iii. **Matthew 1:20-22** Allows us to see the faith he had in God.
  - iv. **Matthew 1:24-25**
  - v. Hebrew Yeshua ... English Jesus ... means ... "The Lord Saves."
- f. Mary comes from Miriam which means "Sea of Bitterness."
  - i. She was a virgin, pledged to be married to Joseph.
  - ii. Both her and Joseph were from the Line of David.

  - iv. Three things said about Mary:
    - 1. She was highly favored Greek <u>Charitoo</u> (Car-Eat-Toe) ... English <u>Favored</u> ... Means ... "To Bestow favor on ... To Highly favor."
