- <u>Dicionary.com</u> defines <u>Covenant</u> as ... "An agreement between two parties to do ... or ... not to do something specified."
- Greek ... <u>Diatheke</u> ... (*Dee-Atha-Kay*) ... English <u>Covenant</u> ... "A solemn agreement between God and man ... where the stronger sets the standards."
- <u>Dictionary.com</u> defines <u>Mission</u> as ... "An important goal or purpose that is accompanied by strong conviction ... calling or vocation."
- Greek <u>Diakonia</u> ... English Mission ... "Active service, done with a willing attitude ... empowered and guided by faith."

- c. **Morris Mandel** ... "Gossip is the deadliest microbe. It has neither legs nor wings. It is composed entirely of tales, and most of them sting."
