- b. Greek <u>Chairo</u> (*Hi-Row*) ... English <u>Gladly</u> ... means ... "*Rejoicing* ... *To be glad* ... with happiness."
- c. We need to understand, the world will judge you, but who cares?
- d. If the world judged Jesus ... they are going to judge you.
- e. Greek <u>Diagongyzo</u> (*Dia-Gone-Goozo*) ... English <u>Mutter</u> ... means ... "*To complain and grumble*."

- g. Isaiah 5:20-21
- h. Psalm 139:13-14
