- b. The Jewish custom is to circumcise all boys on the eighth day. But why then?
- c. Genesis 17:10-12
- d. But still, why the eighth day? Well, believe it or not, it is on the eighth day of a male's life that his Vitamin K and Prothrombin levels are at their peak. It is the only time in a male's life that they will be at a perfect level.
- e. Both Vitamin K and Prothrombin are imperative in the clotting process of the body. So, on the eighth day of life *when God said to circumcise all males*, their clotting ability is at the perfect level so that the child would not bleed out, as well as, their immune system is strengthened from the natural antibodies from the mother's breastmilk.
