 - What was wrong with what Jesus said in – **Matthew 22:36-40**

 - Why would anyone in their right mind not be okay with – **John 13:34-35**

1. Reason:

- a. **Hebrew – Hiph** ... English – Reason ... means, “*To discuss ... To decide ... To Adjudge.*”
- b. **Isaiah 1:18**
- c. God created us with the ability to reason which helps us to find truth.
- d. Can nothing really produce something?
- e. **Hebrews 3:4**
- f. If there is no God, which would be the source of TRUTH, *then how can we know what a LIE is?* There must be a source of lies.
- g. **John 8:44**
- h. The fact that there is EVIL, proves that there is GOOD. And the fact that there are LIES, proves there must be TRUTH. If not, how do we know the difference between the two? Reason leads us to the answer.

- a. Artemis II Lunar Mission (April 2026)
- b. Human DNA contains enough information to fill 35,000 books.
- c. Question – Have you ever seen an Owner’s Manual for something accidental?

3. Nature:

- a. **Psalm 19:1**

- c. *Made In His Image* – Institute for Creation Research - 2023
- d. The Earth weighs six sextillion, 570 quintillion tons.
- e. It is 8K miles in diameter ... 25K miles in circumference.
- f. The Earth rotates 595 million miles a year around the sun, and yet its time to do this does not vary by 1 milli-second.
- g. The Earth is perfectly tilted at 23.5 degrees ... If that would vary one way or the other – half of the Earth would freeze, while the other half would fry.
- h. The oxygen level in the oceans and seas is 5-8 mg/L. It is perfect for sea life to live.
- i. Human saliva have FOUR basic functions:
 1. Without it we could not speak.
 2. It helps with chewing and swallowing by breaking food down and lubricating it.
 3. It breaks down starches, so digestion begins as you chew.
 4. It dissolves food to allow the tongue to absorb flavor. (Amen!)
- j. The complexity in which God designed the Human Body is amazing.

- a. What is Intuition? ... Dictionary.com ... *“A direct perception of Truth ... an immediate apprehension.”*
- b. We can see this among the pagan tribes and peoples in the world that it is intuitive for man to say, *“There is something higher than me ... something greater than me ... Someone or something that did all this.”*
- c. Some say about those who worship false gods around the world long before Christianity came ... *“Why do they need to change from what they know to some Westernized idea of God?”*
 1. Their eternity is on the line.
 2. The church has been called to share the Gospel.
 3. When we discover something that will better our lives, to not share it would be selfish.
